



## PRIMARY: PRESCHOOL + KINDERGARTEN

### Community items (**do not label** these items)

- 1 bottle of Clorox Green Works Spray (we like this brand best)
- 4 boxes tissues, cube shaped box (\*full-time students only)
- 1 two-pack of Elmer's PURPLE disappearing glue sticks

### Personal items, to be kept at school (**label** with your child's name)

- 1 pair of rubber rain boots, name written on the OUTSIDE (these may not be worn home)
- 1 pair of inside shoes (slippers, Crocs or similar soft shoes)
- 1 complete change of clothing (short-sleeved shirt, long pants, underwear and socks)
- Lunch box or lunch bag
- Water bottle with SPORTS TOP ONLY (screw-off lids spill, often on someone else's lunch)
- Cloth napkin to pack every day in your child's lunch
- Small stuffed animal or doll to leave at school for quiet time
- NEW: Tot Cot required for all PRESCHOOL students. May be ordered on your own from Amazon (more choices) or a pink or blue version from the Office by June 29. See email from Nancy dated June 11.
- KINDERGARTENERS will only need a pillow and blanket labeled with their name for the occasional quiet time. If you prefer, you may order a Tot Cot (see above).

### Suggested items

- Foldable rain jacket
- Sun hat
- Sunscreen with your child's name to be kept at school and applied in the afternoon
- Chapstick with your child's name to be kept at school

## SUPPLY NOTES FOR PRIMARY PARENTS

Primary students do not need backpacks. Due to limited locker space, we will supply primary students with a special bag and folder. Children will receive their bag at orientation, the open classroom time or the first day of school.



## LOWER ELEMENTARY: GRADES 1/2/3

Community items (**do not label** these items)

- 3 boxes tissues—cube box size
- 1 container Clorox or Green Works disinfecting cleaning wipes
- **1 art supply item (Wendy will email families about this)?**
- 1 2-pack of glue sticks
- Spiral bound art sketchbook, 5.5 x 8.5, 60-100 sheets
  
- Personal items, to be kept at school (**do not label** these items)
- 1” 3-ring binder—plain white, to be personalized at school
- 1” 3-ring binder—plain black, to be personalized at school
  
- Personal items, to be kept at school (**label** these items with your child’s name)
- 1 pair of rubber rain boots, to be kept at school
- 1 pair of inside shoes (slippers, Crocs or similar soft shoes), to be kept at school
- 1 short sleeve shirt, 1 pair of pants, 1 pair of underwear, and 1 pair of socks
- Lunchbox or lunch bag and water bottle

## SUPPLY NOTES FOR LOWER ELEMENTARY PARENTS

Lower Elementary students do not need backpacks. Due to limited cubby space we will supply Lower Elementary students with a special messenger bag. Children will receive their bag at the open classroom or on their first day of school.

### **Please label EVERYTHING!**

Please use a permanent marker to label every single thing your child could possibly wear or bring to school. Please **DO** label all new, old, or handed-down clothing and clearly identify other things (books, shells, vacation souvenirs etc.) If the item comes to school in a Ziploc bag, please also label the bag!



## UPPER ELEMENTARY: GRADES 4/5

### Community items (**do not label** these items)

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 bottle of dishwashing liquid (Green Works or Dawn, no lotion varieties)
- 1 bottle of Green Works spray
- 1 pack adhesive bandages (assorted sizes - plain)
- Spiral bound art sketchbook, 5.5 x 8.5, 60-100 sheets

### Personal Items: (**label** these items with your child's name)

- 8.5" x 11" clipboard with any pattern or image that is school appropriate (please do not send clipboards with paper compartments, calculators or other attachments, or that are oversized)
- Lunch box or lunch bag and water bottle with sports cap
- 4 PLASTIC pocket folders, your choice of color/appropriate design
- 3 ruled composition notebooks
- Earbuds, placed inside some kind of small container or wound onto a spool for storage
- Durable, compact pencil case
- 24 #2 pencils with your student's name printed on them. Places to order these include Oriental Trading Co. and Explicitly Yours Pencils. You may also label pencils with permanent marker.
- 1 pair of rain boots
- 1 pair of indoor shoes or slippers
- Backpack or schoolbag (see below for recommendations)

### Personal Items: (**label** items listed below!)

- 8.5" x 11" clipboard, your choice of color/appropriate design. Please do not send clipboards with paper compartments, calculators or other attachments, or that are oversized.
- 4 PLASTIC pocket folders, your choice of color/appropriate design
- 2 ruled composition notebook
- Music Grade 7 only, set of 3-ring dividers for music class/ukulele tribe (Gr 8 students have this already)
- Music Grade 7 only, 1" white 3-ring binder for music class/ukulele tribe (Gr 8 students have this already)
- 1 durable, compact pencil case
- 24 #2 pencils with your student's name printed on them. Places to order these include Oriental Trading Co. and Explicitly Yours Pencils. You may also label pencils with permanent marker.
- 1 pair of rain boots
- 1 pair of indoor shoes or slippers
- Earbuds, placed inside some kind of small container or wound onto a spool for storage
- Lunch box or lunch bag and water bottle with sports lid.
- Backpack or schoolbag (see below for recommendations)
- Grade 6 students: Scientific calculator preferably solar & battery powered (**not graphing**). Please save the instructions.
