POSITION SUMMARY

Early Care Staff will protect the welfare students and facilitate activities during early care hours, 7:00am-9:00am. Early Care Staff facilitate activities designed to promote social, physical, and intellectual growth following the philosophies of Maria Montessori and the McGuffey Montessori School. This position requires love, patience, and respect for children ages 6-13, encouraging them to be independent while modeling appropriate manners and behaviors. Early Care Staff will prepare the daily snack for classrooms before students arrive, 7:00am-7:30am.
